

Notice on the tourist contribution levied by the City of Kelsterbach for overnight guests as a state-recognised tourist destination

The City of Kelsterbach will levy a tourist contribution from 1 January 2025. This serves to partially cover the costs of creating, expanding, maintaining, and marketing the tourist facilities as well as the events organised for these purposes.

The basis for this is the statute on the levying of a tourist contribution in the city of Kelsterbach (tourist contribution statute).

Who is subject to the tourist contribution?

All non-residents, regardless of the actual purpose of their stay in Kelsterbach, are required to pay the contribution for a paid overnight stay.

What are the costs?

The tourist contribution is two euros per person per night. Registration and payment of the tourist contribution must be made to the host, who will issue a receipt.

The obligation to pay the contribution begins on the day of arrival and ends on the day of departure. Both days count as one day for the calculation of the tourist contribution.

Exceptions

Anyone who was unable to use the tourist facilities during the booked period will be exempted from paying the tourist contribution on presentation of a medical certificate. A written application must be submitted to the town of Kelsterbach. Children and young people up to the age of 18 and persons with a disability of at least 50 per cent are also exempt from paying the fee.

The town of Kelsterbach wishes all visitors a pleasant stay in Kelsterbach.
